EVENT DETAILS

Accommodation

This year's International Healey Weekend will be held at the Bailbrook House Hotel in Bath, Somerset, BA1 7JD. Bailbrook House is a beautiful 4 star, grade 2 listed, 19th century country house hotel set in 20 acres. It is just minutes from the centre of Bath and is conveniently located within easy reach of the M4 and A46.

Our weekend package includes bed and breakfast on Friday and Saturday as well as dinner on Friday evening, lunch, afternoon tea and a Gala Dinner on Saturday night and lunch on Sunday. The package also includes the cost of all admissions and tickets for our planned activities throughout the weekend. Put simply, the only expenses you will have between arrival on Friday afternoon and leaving after lunch on Sunday will be your drinks and petrol.

Itinerary

Friday 5th July – Arrive at the hotel and check in to your room, (Check in from 15:00). Meet everyone for welcome pre-dinner drinks and event briefing at 19:00. Our buffet style evening meal will then be served from 19:30. Following dinner we'll spend the evening socialising.

Saturday 6th July – We'll take breakfast before assembling to sign on for the planned drive. Route books will be issued and we're away on our scenic drive through Somerset to The West Somerset Railway. On arrival we'll board our steam train to the seaside town of Minehead, taking lunch on the way. After a short stop-over in Minehead we'll board our train for the return journey, this time enjoying a cream tea. Once back at our hotel we'll get ready for Saturday night's Gala Dinner.

Sunday 7th July – Breakfast, followed by a morning of sightseeing and shopping in beautiful Bath Spa. We'll take a short walk from our hotel to Bathampton Mill and take a short boat trip on the River Avon right into the heart of the city. Disembarking at Pulteney Weir, we will be close to the historic Royal Crescent, The Circus, Bath Abbey, Roman Baths and the city centre shopping. Guided walking tours are available at our disembarkation point should you wish to take advantage of these, but if you prefer you can just make your own plans. Following the morning's visit to Bath we'll return to the hotel for our farewell buffet lunch.
